1,000 acres protected! I am so excited to share that in 2022 we are on track to pass this major milestone!

I'm asking you to help us make it happen. Our total holdings currently include 613 acres with an additional 352 acres under conservation restrictions that prohibit development. We have several projects already in the pipeline for next year and expect to add significant acreage in Bellingham and Mendon and to accept new conservation restrictions in Northbridge, Sutton and Uxbridge. It's truly an exciting time for MLT and we want you to be a part of it.

*"We love where we live."* That has been our mantra for several years. It's what keeps us talking to others about the land and the nature it supports. It's what keeps us at meetings and working late into the night, researching property history and discovering new and creative ways to help land owners preserve their property for the generations that will follow them. Our work protects wildlife, preserves scenic vistas and promotes environmental awareness. But, ultimately, our work serves all of us.

I am proud to report that our all-volunteer board works hard to leverage our limited resources to the maximum conservation extent possible. We apply for grants, encourage volunteers to help document a property's conservation values, provide high school students with meaningful and safe volunteer roles in stewardship and vernal pool certification and work to raise money from individuals and businesses alike. We work closely with each property's owner and its community and we have successfully partnered with organizations that share our goals.
